Are you interested in learning how to combine the latest research on teaching while earning your clear credential and a Master's in Education?

The Induction Action Research Program, Emphasis on Teaching program will help you use research and practitioner literature to address problems of practice in your classroom while developing an inquiry-based mindset to improve your instructional skills.

Our approach

Reach believes that an inquiry and research-based approach to teaching is vitally important to high quality teaching. The program supports teachers to move from using habits of inquiry in addressing problems of practice to designing robust research questions and consulting research and professional literature to expand their thinking about their practice. Teachers apply this new knowledge to a problem of practice, gather resultant data and analyze their findings.

Goals of the program:

Candidates who complete the Induction Action Research Program, earn a Master's in Education and a California Clear Teaching Credential while developing into skilled classroom leaders, with a mindset toward inquiry in education.

Who is eligible:

- Teachers who have completed our Teaching Academy's Intern Program, earning a Preliminary Credential through Reach.
- Teachers who have a preliminary California teaching credential, or the equivalent from another accredited credentialing institution may be eligible upon completion of one year of the Induction Program and an additional course. Teachers interested in this option should contact Reach as soon as possible for additional information.
- Any teacher who has completed the regular Reach BTSA Induction program (ECO excluded)

Requirements:

- Teachers must have at least one class of students in their credential area.

Credentials/Degrees earned:

- California Clear Teaching Credential
- Master of Education in Teaching*

Tuition (currently subsidized by grants):

- \$2,800

*Masters Degrees are currently not WASC accredited.
