Are you interested in developing your facilitation and professional development leadership skills?

Our approach

Reach believes that high quality ongoing professional learning is a critical factor in improving schools. However, teacher leaders are often asked to lead professional learning communities without being given the training and support to develop their own skills. In the Facilitation Certificate Program, you will be introduced to adult learning theory, research-based professional development frameworks, and develop your facilitation skills.

Goals of the program:

Facilitation Certificate holders will be able to design and build effective professional learning communities, and will develop a toolbox to analyze and effectively respond to challenging facilitation situations.

Who is eligible:

- Teacher leaders, coaches or current administrators.
- You must have a facilitation role (i.e. co-presenting PD, grade level chair, dept. chair, PLC or inquiry group lead, etc.)

Certificate Requirements:

- How Teachers Learn (Reach 430; 2 units)
- Fostering Communities of Practice (Reach 460; 2 units)
- Participate in 2 Coaching Cycles (Reach 480; 1 unit)
- Pass the Reach Facilitation Performance Assessment

Certificate earned:

- Facilitation Certificate

Cost:

- \$1,000 per individual course (no certificate) or
- \$2,750 for the facilitation certificate (2 courses, coaching cycles, performance assessment and units)
